Town of Pelzer General Election

The Municipal Election Commission of the Town of Pelzer announces the general election for Town of Pelzer to be Tuesday, November 7, 2017.

The following offices shall be included in this election:

One (1) mayor and four (4) council members

The polling place is the Pelzer Community Building in Pelzer Park located at 25 Pelzer Park Street.

Persons desiring to vote in this election must be registered by Friday, October 7, 2017 (or 30 days prior). To register, one should contact the Anderson County Board of Voter Registration at (864) 260-4035.

You will be asked to show one of the following Photo ID's at your polling place:

*S.C. Driver's License *ID card issued by S.C. Dept. of Motor Vehicles

*S.C. Voter Registration card with photo *Federal Military ID *U.S. Passport

Citizens desiring to be candidates for the above listed office may file at Pelzer Town Hall, 103 Courtney Street in Pelzer. Books will be open for filing at noon, August 10, 2017 and remain open during regular business hours until noon, August 24, 2017

Mayor \$50.00

Council \$25.00

This is a nonpartisan election and no party affiliation will be placed on the ballot.

The polls shall open at 7:00 a.m. and close at 7:00 p.m. on Election Day.

At 9:00 a.m. on Election Day, the poll manager(s) will begin examination of absentee ballot return envelopes. This examination will be held at the Anderson County Board of Elections at 301 N. Main Street, Anderson, SC 29621.

On Thursday, November 9, 2017 at 11:30 AM at the Anderson County Board of Elections at 301 N. Main Street, Anderson, SC 29621, the Municipal Election Commission will hold a hearing to determine the validity of ballots challenged in this election.

In the event of a tie, any run-off will be held two weeks after the election on Tuesday, November 21, 2017.
