Mayor Ragland advised residents that we received a quote to add the following lights – 6 – Orr, 5 – Finley, 6 – Hampton, 2 – Blythe, 5 – Connor, 3 – Frost, 5 – Parker, 3 – Stevenson, and 4 – Stewart for an additional monthly cost of \$403.00. Mayor Ragland made motion to accept the quote and add the additional lights, Eddie Waits 2nd the motion, all in favor.
